Are you considering getting involved with ASCA and the 2019 Conference Committee? Get involved two in two ways: 1) submit a program proposal and/or 2) become a program reviewer for the 2019 ASCA Annual Conference!

Program Proposal

The Conference Committee is soliciting the following session types for this year's conference:

Concurrent Program Sessions

Traditional 60 minute sessions that are focused on the learning priorities of the organization. While the conference theme is relevant, the contact should outshine the conference theme.

Roundtable Sessions

These are 60 minute pre-planned discussions that are designed to facilitate conversation among peers on a topic relevant to the field (Please note: there is generally no A/V available for roundtable sessions.)

Program proposals for the aforementioned session types should demonstrate clear evidence of planning, organization, content expertise or experience, clearly stated learning outcomes and objectives, and be relevant to the field of student conduct.

As a reminder, all program proposals are due by **5:00 p.m. EST on Tuesday, September 4th, 2018.**

When submitting your program proposal, please keep in mind the following:

- Provide accurate information for any and all co-presenters.
 - Scheduling conflicts may occur and may not be resolved if all co-presenters are not submitted to the Conference Committee in a timely manner.
- The abstract provided in the proposal will be included in conference promotional materials.
- Presenters will be responsible for supplying all display materials and handouts.
- Please review [ASCA's Statement of Diversity](#).

Program proposals will be reviewed by the following criteria:

- Abstract (which will be included in Guidebook), description and learning objectives are clearly articulated
- Abstract and description are clearly related
- Proposals should focus on the content of the presentation, conference theme relevancy and the purpose and goals of ASCA.

Program Reviewer

Each year, numerous professionals in ASCA including yourself serve in a critical role of program reviewer. The Conference Committee is seeking professionals of a diverse background who are innovative, and passionate for the field of student conduct to help select this year's conference educational programs. Program reviewers include all ranges of experience, content expertise, and involvement within ASCA and student affairs to ensure a breadth of perspectives are reflected in the review of program proposals.

To become a program reviewer, please complete the Program Reviewer Interest Form. In order to ensure all program proposals are evaluated in a timely manner, all Program Reviewer Interest Forms must be completed by **5:00 p.m. EST on Monday, August 20th, 2018.** Please note all program proposal reviews will be conducted from Monday, September 17th, 2018 and Monday, October 1st, 2018 and will be completed through Precis, through electronic submission.

All program reviewers will be contacted with further instructions on participating in the program review process. Your feedback and contribution to the Association is much appreciated and will greatly assist the Conference Committee in selecting programs for the 2019 ASCA Annual Conference.
